The National Weather Service, Pendleton, Oregon Office, as of December 18th, 2025 at 8:00am, has provided the following information for Klickitat County.

- The Klickitat River near Pitt: is currently under a Flood Watch, with minor flood stage expected to be reached by Friday (December 19th) morning, before receding on Saturday (December 20th).
- Other rivers and streams across the east foothills of the Cascades are expected to see rises through Friday into Saturday, before trending downward by early next week.
- Low-lying areas along rivers and streams along the east slopes of the Cascades may experience (or continue to experience) flooding as a result of heavy mountain precipitation today.

The Klickitat County Department of Emergency Management encourages County Residents to be aware of the conditions in your area, and to monitor Local Media and the National Weather Service for forecasts and warnings.

Do Not attempt to drive through flood water over roadways. It may be deeper and moving faster than you think. The roadway may have washed away. "Turn Around – Do Not Drown"

If flood waters are threatening your home, call the Emergency Management's 24-hour Dispatch phone line at 509-773-4545.

The Klickitat County Department of Emergency Management will send Alerts when necessary to residents in affected areas using its Emergency Notification System.
