Update:

Lyle Hill Fire started on June 28, 2026 at approximately 1:45 PM. The fire is located 10 miles Northwest of The Dalles, OR adjacent to the community of Lyle, WA. The cause of the fire is under investigation.

Initial attack resources responding to the Lyle Hill Fire were able to stop forward progress of the fire last night. Today crews will focus on strengthening fire lines and keeping the fire within its current perimeter. Aircraft will continue to be used to support firefighters on the ground as needed.

Weather and Fire Behavior: Winds are predicted to be 15-25 miles per hour in the fire area with gusts up to 45 miles per hour. Temperatures will remain cooler than normal with no rain in the forecast.

Air Space Restrictions:

There is a Temporary Flight Restriction (TFR) in place over the fire. Any unaccounted-for aircraft, including drones, puts aerial firefighting resources and lives at risk. If you fly, we can't. All firefighting aircraft must be grounded if unmanned aircraft or drones are operating near the fire.
