



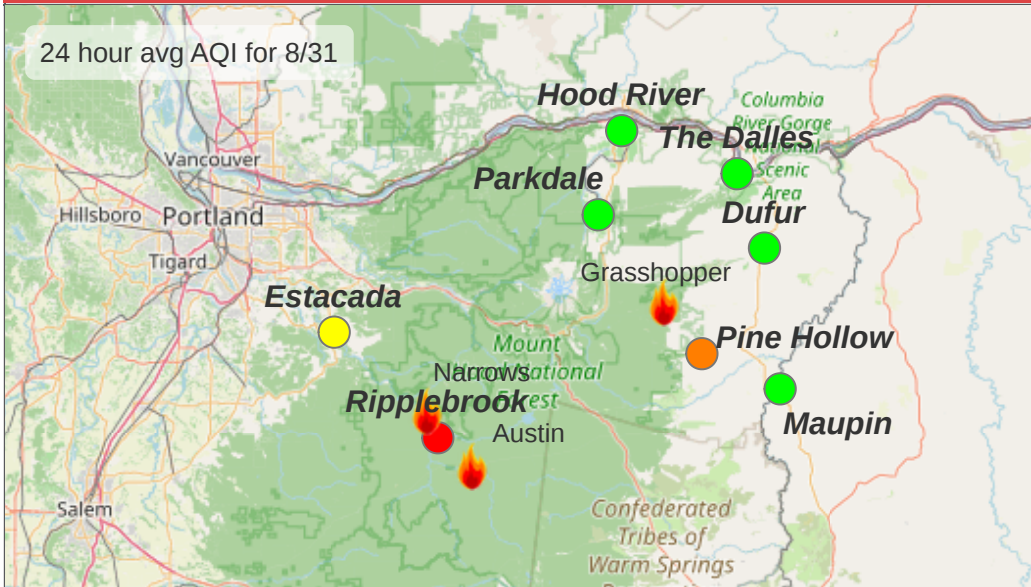

FIRE

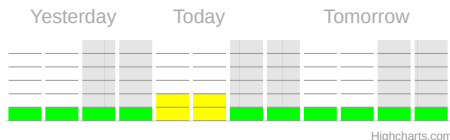
The **Grasshopper** fire is currently estimated at 93961 acres and is 83% contained. Fire activity for the **Grasshopper** fire is expected to decrease. The **Austin** fire is currently estimated at 11682 acres and is 0% contained. Fire activity for the **Austin** fire is expected to remain active. The **Narrows** fire is currently estimated at 301 acres and is 11% contained. Fire activity for the **Narrows** fire is expected to remain low.

SMOKE

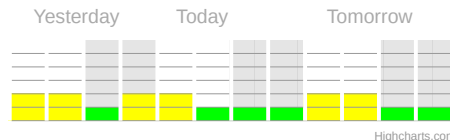
Warmer and drier air over the fires will increase fire activity today. Winds from the east and southeast will bring increased smoke to communities west of the fires. Smoke from the **Grasshopper** fire will continue to impact the communities closest to the fire. **Pine Hollow** will experience **USG** air quality. Areas near the **Austin** fire along the **Clackamas River** are expected to experience higher concentrations of smoke and **VERY UNHEALTHY** air quality. Areas near **Dufur** and **Maupin** may experience some smoke, but overall **GOOD** air quality today. Areas across the **Willamette Valley** and along the **Columbia River** will see increased smoke and widespread haze that will persist through the day and begin to clear in the early evening. Air quality in these areas will largely remain **GOOD**. **Estacada** and areas around **Mount Hood**, including **Government Camp**, will experience **MODERATE** air quality today. 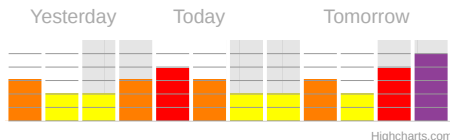
Parkdale GOOD air quality with periods of smoke expected.



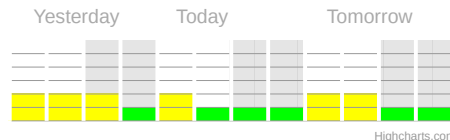
Dufur GOOD air quality expected with periods of light smoke



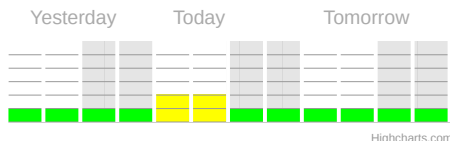
Pine Hollow **USG** air quality.



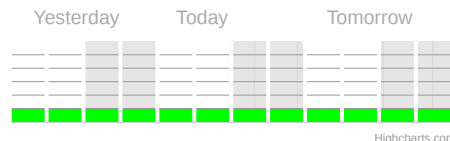
Maupin GOOD air quality with periods of smoke.
